I, Pitchuka Poorna Chandra Mohan Rao (Director – Operations) of LG Polymers India Private Limited, located at Sy. Nos. 1 to 46 at Venkatapuram Village, Visakhapatnam District and Sy. Nos. 77 to 83 and Sy. Nos. 111 to 118 at Vepagunta Village, Pendurti Mandal, Visakhapatnam District, Andhra Pradesh, do hereby solemnly affirm and swear as under:-

- In 1997, LG Polymers India Private Limited took over this manufacturing facility from M/s McDowell & Company. The unit was established at the site in 1965 by M/s. Hindustan Polymers Limited and the said Hindustan Polymers Ltd, was amalgamated with McDowell & Company in 1982 comprising production of Styrene, Polystyrene and Alcohol-based Distillery (Raw material for production of styrene). Subsequently, considering the proximity of populated areas, McDowell & Company decided to decommission polluting plants such as production of styrene and the alcohol-based distillery. Presently, our unit has facility for manufacture of Polystyrene and Expandable Polystyrene from imported styrene and reprocessing of primary plastics into Engineering Plastics.

- 2 LG Polymers India Pvt. Ltd. obtained Consent for Establishment for this unit vide Order no. CFE/APPCB/HO/R00/CFE/2001/9 dated 16.11.2001 and Consent for Operation for manufacture of Polystyrene (233.3 TPD) and Expandable Polystyrene (45 TPD) vide order no. APPCB/VSP/109/HO/2002/A/37-298 dated 08.05.2002.
- 3 Subsequently, minor expansions of the facility were undertaken after duly obtaining Consents for Establishment/Operation from the Andhra Pradesh Pollution Control Board (APPCB). Further, LG Polymers India Pvt. Ltd. has installed plant capacity of 36.67 TPD for Engineering Plastics, which is a downstream product involving reprocessing of primary plastics after obtaining CFE/CFO from APPCB.

The broad chronology of Consents for Operation obtained for expansions of the facility is as under:

- 4 That on my application for Environmental Clearance for enhancement in Polystyrene and Expandable Polystyrene manufacturing capacity, it was noticed by concerned authority, State level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) that the present manufacture of Polystyrene and Expandable Polystyrene is in operation without a valid Environmental Clearance (EC) and is observed to be a 'violation' as per applicable statute in vogue.
- 5 That, prior environment clearance was not taken for the said manufacturing activity as per the provisions of Environment Impact Assessment Notification, 2006 (hereinafter called as "EIA Notification, 2006") as no clearance was obtained vide entry 5(e) – "Petrochemical based processing (processes other than cracking & reformation and not covered under the complexes)" in schedule to the EIA Notification, 2006.
- 6 As on this date our industry does not have a valid Environmental Clearance substantiating the produced quantity, issued by the competent authority, for continuing operations. However, we are continuing our plant operations with valid consent for operation from State Pollution Control Board, Andhra Pradesh. Further I submit that the conditions specified in the CFE/CFO have been fulfilled to the satisfaction of APPCB.
- 7 That Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change vide notification number S.O. 804 (E), dated 14th March 2017 has notified the process for appraisal of projects for grant of Terms of Reference and Environmental Clearances, which have started the work

on site, expanded the production beyond the limit of environmental clearance or changed the product mix without obtaining prior environmental clearance as mandated under the EIA Notification, 2006 and permitted project proponents to apply for environment clearance under this notification only within six months from the date of the said notification.

- 8 That the Hon'ble Supreme Court, vide judgment dated 2nd August 2017 in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 114 of 2014 in the matter of Common Cause versus Union of India and Ors., has passed a detailed order interpreting Section 21(5) of the MMDR Act, 1957 and directing payment of 100% penalty for illegal operations with reference to the relevant statutes, which inter-alia, include the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and the Mines and Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act, 1957.
- 9 That Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change vide notification number S.O. 1030(E) dated 8th March 2018 to streamline and expedite consideration of proposals, has decided that projects/activities covered under category 'B' shall be considered by the SEAC/SEIAAs in the respective States/UTs.
- 10 That Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change vide Office Memorandum F.No.Z-11013/22/2017-IA.II (M) dated 16th March 2018 in light of the orders of the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Madras vide Order dated 14th March 2018 in WMP Nos. 3361 and 3362 of 2018 and WMP No. 3721 of 2018 in WP No. 11189 of 2017 has granted 30 days additional time from the dated of that order to make fresh applications to those who have not submitted applications till then and also directed proponents who have already made applications in terms of the S.O. 804 (E), dated 14th March 2017 to submit applications afresh within 30 days.
- 11 That Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change vide office Memorandum F.No.3-50/2017-IA.III(Pt.) dated 30th May 2018 in terms of the directions given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, in judgments dated 2nd August 2017 in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 114 of 2014 in the matter of Common Cause verses Union of India and Ors., has issued directions to the project proponents.
- 12 That I am aware of the scoping and appraising of my Environmental Clearance (EC) application is subject to the condition(s) that I will follow all the Rules, Regulations, Bye-laws made there under from time to time related with the operations that, I have proposed for expansion. I am also aware that the above Rules, Regulations, Bye-laws made there under can be from any Governmental department which is directly or indirectly related to the operations and/or ancillary operations of unit.

- 17 I am also aware that the appraising of the present Environmental Clearance (EC) application is subject to submission of Bank Guarantee equivalent to the sum needed for redemption management plan and natural & community resource augmentation plans. These will be the value as calculated by 'Accredited consultant' who is engaged by me.
- 18 I am also aware that the falsification of the information submitted if any in the supporting documents or measurements for arriving at Bank Guarantee, will make my Environmental Clearance (EC) appraisal liable to be rejected forthwith, pending further criminal actions applicable if any, along with forfeiture of the Bank Guarantee submitted by me.
- 19 I am also aware that the present appraising of Environmental Clearance (EC) application shall not form a prejudice to any other law applicable to the nature of operations for which the appraisal is requested for. I am also aware that the 'Bank Guarantee' shall be for a period equivalent to the time needed for carrying the redemption works, and resource augmentation works if any.
